

## Eligibility for Nomination

To be eligible as an inbound exchange student to UNO, the student:

1. must be a current undergraduate or graduate student at UNO's partner university through University Partnership, MAUI-Utrecht, or ISEP.
2. And, has been nominated by home university coordinator to UNO through the nomination form during the open nomination period.

## Requirements for Application/Successful Admission

### 1. Submit the Scanned Copy of Passport

Color scans or photos are preferred in pdf or jpeg format. Legible copy only. Passports must be valid for 6 months beyond the student's intended departure date from the home university/home country.

### 2. Submit the Transcript(s)

Transcripts must be current including all the earned academic credits and translated to English. For inbound exchange students, undergraduate-level, minimum of 2.0 GPA on a 4.0 GPA scale. For inbound exchange students, graduate-level, must provide transcripts for all degrees completed, including the bachelor's degree in addition to the current transcript. Inbound exchange students, graduate-level, do not require a minimum GPA.

If transcripts are not issued in English, please also submit certified English translations. The certified English translation can be completed by a translator who provides a signed statement and indicates that the translation is accurate and true to the original.

Transcripts submitted will be used to waive prerequisites and request permission to enroll in higher level courses in the student's field of study. It is important that all earned academic credits are included on the submitted transcript(s).

### 3. Submit the Proof of English Proficiency

Students from Australia, Canada, Ireland, New Zealand, and the United Kingdom whose first language is English are exempt from this requirement. TOEFL, IELTS, PTE Academic or Duolingo results are the preferred indicators of English proficiency. Applicants whose first language is not English can submit one of the following:

For undergraduate level of study, TOEFL IBT/PBT 61/500 or TOEFL iBT Home Edition 61. IELTS 6.0. Duolingo English Exam 95. PTE Academic 44. ACT English Sub Score 18. SAT Reading Sub Score 24. UNO Certificate of English Language Proficiency

For graduate level of study, TOEFL IBT/PBT 80/550. IELTS 6.5. PTE Academic 53. Duolingo English Exam 105. UNO Certificate of English Language Proficiency [https://www.unomaha.edu/international-studies-and-programs/study-abroad/\\_files/docs/english-proficiency-form-updated-2019.pdf](https://www.unomaha.edu/international-studies-and-programs/study-abroad/_files/docs/english-proficiency-form-updated-2019.pdf) completed by the student's professor or instructor of English, or a director of an English language program. The proof of English Proficiency should be within 2 years. Other English proficiency exams are not accepted.

#### 4. Submit the UNO Financial Affidavit

Students must provide proof that they have the financial resources to live and study in the United States. Please download the most recent UNO Financial Affidavit for Inbound Exchange students, fill it out, and submit it to the application form.

#### 5. Submit the Supporting Documents for UNO Financial Affidavit

To complete the most recent UNO Financial Affidavit, please submit the bank document to the application form. A recent bank statement or letter from the bank shows adequate funds for the duration of the program to cover personal expenses and any fees that cannot be waived. The tuition and some fees are waived with the nomination, and the student's financial supporting documents must show the total balance listed on the most recent UNO Financial Affidavit on page 2, section 2.

 Summer Sessions - optional term, from late May to mid August, 6 weeks or 12 weeks of study

Academic Year - Fall Semester + Spring Semester, from late August to mid May
