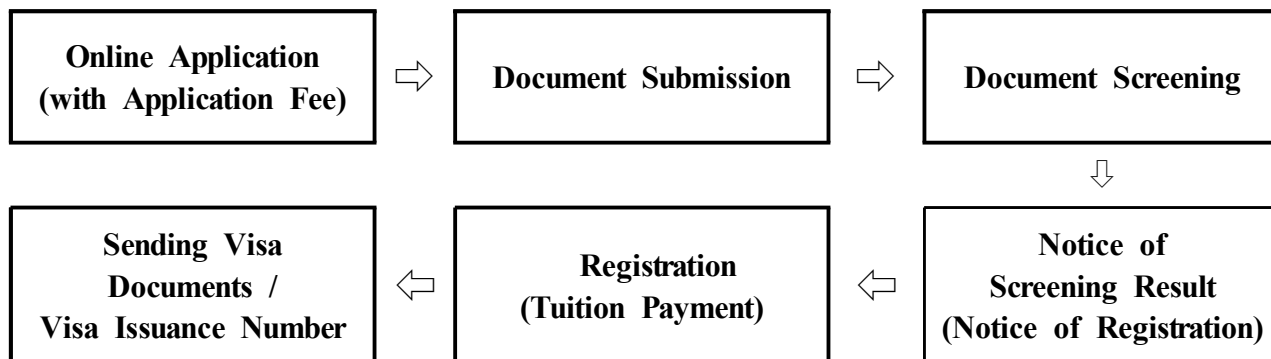

- 3) Two recommendation letters from two professors from the last attended educational institution.
- 4) Original Household Register or notarized copy that includes all household members.
- 5) Certificates of Employment of both father and mother; either parent can be the primary sponsor of the applicant. (However, students applying from China need to provide Certificates of Employment and Certificates of Income of both parents.)

5. Application Fee

- 1) Application Fee: 100,000 KRW or 100 USD.
- 2) International Transfer to designated Daegu Bank Account or direct payment at the Administration Office of the Graduate School.
- 3) Please note that application will not be processed without paid application fee.

6. Additional Information for Application

- 1) All the required documents must be translated into Korean or English.
- 2) Official report of English or Korean Proficiency test taken by May 10, 2010 (TOEFL, TOEIC, TEPS, IELTS, KLPT, KLAT or TOPIK) should be included in the application package, if applicable.
- 3) Chinese applicants who need to get an entry visa to Korea should submit the following documents even though an academic supervisor guarantees financial support.
 - Certificates of Employment, Certificates of Income and Original copy of Bank Statements for both father and mother, respectively
- 4) When the academic supervisor guarantees financial support for an applicant, the applicant does not need to submit his/her Certificate of Employment, Certificate of Income and Original copy of Bank Statements.
- 5) The applicant should select the exact major and department that he/she is applying for. Any disadvantage caused by the applicant's mistake is her/his responsibility and application documents and fees will not be refunded.

11. Visa Issue

Nationality	Procedure
China	1. Yeungnam University applies for “Visa Issuance Certificate Number” at the Korean Immigration Office in Daegu. 2. The university receives “Visa Issuance Certificate Number” from the Korean Immigration Office in Daegu. 3. The university delivers Visa Number to applicants by e-mail. 4. Applicants apply for "Entry Visa" with the Visa Issuance Certificate Number and the required documents at the Korean Embassy or at a Korean Consulate in China. 5. Applicants obtain “Entry Visa” (D-2), and enter Korea.
Others	1. Yeungnam University mails admission materials, including “Certificate of Admission,” to applicants in order to apply for “Entry Visa”. 2. Applicants apply for "Entry Visa" with the required documents at the Korean Embassy at a Korean Consulate in the applicant’s country. 3. Applicants obtain “Entry Visa” (D-2), and enter Korea.
